Program: "Famous Wedding Veils," presented by Carolyn Cerini
Weddings are always in the news, whether it's our families, or friends, or celebrities, or the "royals". Why do we dress in a certain way, and does it have a particular symbolism. Join Carolyn Cerini at CRLG Fall Lace Day to answer these questions by looking at famous lace wedding veils, other bridal attire, and customs. Perhaps the answers may be unexpected!

Carolyn began making lace in 2001, while still employed full-time. Since retiring in 2007, she has taken many lace-making classes, including one in Bruges, Belgium. While working full-time, she was a historical re-enactor at Sully, the historic home built in Fairfax County in 1794, for almost 15 years. While she no longer does re-enacting, her love of history combined with lace-making led her to begin teaching 2 courses for William & Mary's Adult Ed program known as the Christopher Wren Association.

Having just finished teaching her latest class a week ago, she's now been teaching there for the last 3 years.

Directions to Bethesda United Methodist Church from I-495:

Take Exit 36 for Old Georgetown Road/MD-187 Bethesda/Rockville.

Go .2 miles (2/10ths of a mile). Turn south onto MD-187/ S/Old Georgetown Rd (signs for Bethesda). Coming from the outer loop, you'll turn left.

From inner loop, turn right.

Go 1.7 miles. Arrive at Bethesda United Methodist Church, 8300 Old Georgetown Rd., on your right.
